Lionbridge - Creative Writing Project opportunity for Parauk and Rakhine Speakers

The Lionbridge Global Services for Machine Intelligence have two Creative Writing projects for Parauk and Rakhine (Myanmar) and hope you might be able to help to find suitable candidates.

Creative Writing Project:

Requirement: Native or near-native speakers of Parauk or Rakhine (Myanmar) with access to stable Internet connection.

Estimated start date: As soon as possible.

Task description: This work is performed through an Excel file. The linguist has to create answers to the questions provided by us. The questions are in English, but the answers should be in Parauk or Rakhine (Myanmar), linguistically and grammatically correct, make sense in relation to the question, and must contain at least 6 words. Each question has a minimum number of sentences required, which needs to be followed in the answers. The answers should not be similar to each other. Please find here below the 10 questions for reference to have an idea of what kind of questions they are.

Questions:

1. What is the most prominent cell phone provider in your country? (1 sentence) 2. Please translate: no milk, one dog, two pigs, three chickens, four kids, five trees, seventy-five sons, one hundred stars. (1 sentence)

3. Please list 10 adverbs in your language. Examples: financially, undoubtedly, beautifully. (1 sentence) 4. List the top 20 big cities in Germany. (2 sentences) 5. If you could live inside any movie you have seen, what movie would you pick? Why did you pick it? Is it because of the people? The location/surroundings? (5 sentences)

6. What are some essentials for taking a long road trip? Who would you take it with? Do you prefer to make many stops, or drive as much as possible? Do you like to have deep conversations or play games? Sing along to music? (8 sentences)

7. What is a famous local dish in your country? How would you prepare it? What does it look like? What does it taste like? Do you like it? Why, or why not? (10 sentences)

8. What do you plan to do this weekend? Write a short plan. (10 sentences) 9. Write a summary of your favorite novel. (15 sentences) 10. Write a story about somebody who one day wakes up being in the Mars? What will happen next? Anything can happen! (30 sentences)

Workload:	flexible, preferably 15	hours per week.

Scope: 5006 sentences

Rate: 0.43 USD per sentence, average throughput is 70 sentences per hour (2.152.58USD).

Location: Flexible, the worker can be located anywhere as long as there are a computer and a stable Internet connection.

Monthly salary payments term is 30 days. If PayPal is not available for you, the payment will be via bank transfer.
